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
A Message from our President & CEO, Brian Parchesky

Foster Care | 896

Our Foster Care Program is committed to working alongside foster families to ensure the safe and timely reunification of children with their biological families. When reunification is not possible, our dedicated team works tirelessly to connect youth eligible for adoption with loving, permanent "Forever Families."



Behavioral Health | 1,772

Our Behavioral Health Services empower families to make informed decisions about their care. Through nursing, clinical support, and care management, we provide mental health and substance use services designed to reduce emergency room visits and hospital stays.



Family Preservation | 4,191

Our Family Preservation Programs support families in crisis who are at risk of separation. We partner with parents to provide education, guidance, and reinforcement where they need it most—at home, in schools, and within their communities.



Detention Services | 307

Our Detention Programs provide a secure and supportive environment for youth based on their choices and circumstances. Using a trauma-informed approach, we offer guidance, educational and vocational opportunities, and resources to help them build stronger connections at home and within their communities, empowering them to choose a more positive path.



Group Homes | 36

Our Group Homes provide trauma-informed care for youth navigating challenges at home and in their communities. With a focus on life skills, we empower them to reach their full potential, work toward their goals, and build a path to independence.




Sheltered Hearts | 405

Our Sheltered Hearts Program provides temporary shelter for unaccompanied children while our team works tirelessly to connect them with family members or sponsors in the United States.



A Look Inside Together for Youth





Roadmap to Success™

Trent Griffin-Braaf had a vision—his Roadmap to Success™—shaped by his own experiences following incarceration. His goal was to prepare young men, ages 14 to 18, at Together for Youth's detention facility for the workforce through an 8-week program. However, as he worked with the participants, he realized they needed more than job readiness—they needed personal development, something



many had missed due to their circumstances.

Early on, it became clear that these youth needed more than interview skills—they needed self-esteem, effective communication, and confidence to navigate the world. Trent adapted, shifting the program's focus from career preparation to personal growth.

Week by week, the transformation was evident. The participants became more engaged, their confidence growing with each session. They learned to build resumes and practice interviews but also to set and achieve goals. Trent introduced SMART goals, and by the program's end, participants were setting daily objectives for themselves—habits that could shape their futures.

The journey wasn't without obstacles. Engagement was low in the first week, so Trent introduced incentives, sparking immediate participation. By the program's conclusion, two participants had earned gift cards for outstanding engagement, and three completed a book assignment—one even submitting a full book report.

As the program wrapped up, Trent reflected on their growth. These young men, who entered with challenges, were leaving with a sense of purpose. Post-program surveys confirmed their progress, though Trent saw room for improvement—stronger communication between staff and participants could enhance future success.

Celebrating 25 Years of The Bronx Power Project

For 25 years, Jenifer Gilmore has been a guiding force of hope and transformation through Together for Youth's Bronx Power Project. Her journey is one of resilience, dedication, and an unwavering commitment to at-risk youth.

When Jenifer joined, the Bronx Power Project was in its infancy, building an evidence-based model inspired by Project Adventure. The initiative used adventure-based counseling to support severely hospitalized or heavily medicated youth, many of whom were gang-involved or struggled with severe mental health issues.

In the early days, Jenifer and her team took kids on retreats where they built trust and confidence through outdoor adventures. Many experienced nature for the first time. Committed to preventing youth homelessness, especially for those with mental health challenges, they worked tirelessly to support children aging out of the system.

Over the years, she has seen shifting perceptions of mental health. "There was no social media, no one to talk to about being 15 and hearing voices or dealing with chronic depression," she recalls. The Bronx Power Project became a safe space where youth could open up, often for the first time. "For decades, The Bronx Power Project has provided a safe and supportive space for you," she says.

New challenges emerged, including increased substance-induced mental health issues. Jenifer shares stories of youth ending up in psychiatric

facilities due to drug use. But she remains committed, knowing trust takes time. "We don't have a time limit," she explains. "It could take months, even years, to break through to a teenager who has had so many people come in and out of their lives."

In recent years, art has become a powerful tool in the program's counseling approach. Since the pandemic, many kids express themselves best through creative outlets like painting and drawing, allowing them to communicate emotions words cannot capture.



Jenifer's 25 years with the Bronx Power Project have left an indelible mark. What began as a temporary job turned into a fulfilling career of empowering at-risk youth. As she reflects, she is filled with pride and gratitude, knowing her work has helped transform lives and create a brighter future for the next generation.

Whether squeezing into tight spaces or braving harsh weather, he's done it all. But through this demanding work, Nehemiah realized he wanted more.

Initially, he planned to use his scholarship for a heavy machinery program, but the physically intensive nature of construction made him reconsider. Now, he's setting his sights on higher education, preparing to pursue a four-year degree in computer science at a college in New York City or on Long Island. With applications submitted to several CUNY schools, Nehemiah is determined to carve out a new future.

Beyond academics, he is an active member of his local church, always ready to lend a helping hand. His selflessness and humor make him a positive force in his community. As he navigates this transition, Nehemiah has had strong support from his foster mom, Audrey, and his mentor, Shirley, a Behavioral Health Clinician with Together for Youth. They have guided him through financial aid, housing, and college logistics. With the Mott Scholarship helping to cover costs, he hopes to dorm in the city and fully immerse himself in college life.

Shirley has witnessed Nehemiah's determination firsthand. "Nehemiah has always pushed himself to grow. He is thoughtful about his future and willing to take the steps

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necessary to build a better life," she shares. "It's been incredible to see his journey unfold, and I have no doubt he will continue to thrive." "Nehemiah has always pushed himself to grow."


